Following the title and author information, 3-5 relevant keywords should be italicized at the end of the abstract. The file should submitted in Microsoft Word format (.doc or .docx). The length of full paper would be 3000-7000 words. Paragraphs should be spaced with one line between them, and the margins should be set to 1 inch on all sides, with justified alignment. Reference should follow APA citation style.
